Thanks for the inquiry Mike. Pex is very similar to PB, in part I believe, because some of the same individuals designed the systems. For example, Gary Runyan at Zurn helped launch Zurn's Pex product line after having been deeply involved in PB with his former employer, US Brass.

More lawsuits have been filed against Zurn. Cases seeking class action status are now pending in Minnesota, North Dakota, Colorado, North Carolina and Virginia. I am aware that there have been Zurn Pex product failures in Texas.

I am interested in knowing about any failures (leaks or fully failed fittings) found in the field. It would be helpful if your members emailed me when they come across problems in the field.

Finally, what the general opinion is here is simply that the PEX is a very good product if it is not punctured BUT the connectors are just as scary as the PB connectors if not more so.
